LAMB GRAIN OPTIMISER

INGREDIENTS: (may include)

Cereal Grains and Bran, Expeller Pressed Non-GM Canola Meal, Vegetable Protein Meals, Limestone, Bentonite, Salt, Sodium Bicarbonate, Acid Buf®, Bovatec®, Molasses, Syrup, Minerals, Trace Elements, Vitamins and Ammonium Chloride.

FEEDING GUIDELINES:

- Always provide clean fresh water
- Optimiser and grain mix should not exceed 70% of total intake (approx 2% of animal liveweight). Ration to start at 50:50 with grain for the first 7 - 10 days or until lambs exceed 35kg. After this, the ration can be adjusted to 40:60 (Optimiser:Grain)
- Quality roughage source to be made available through either pasture, hay or straw
- Proper introduction process to be followed, with intake to be built up during the first 7-10 days to avoid sudden changes to the ration
- Best fed through lick feeders with the slide open 10-15mm to avoid gorging. If using a double slide feeder, open each slide approx. 20mm

OTHER:

MSM Lamb Grain Optimiser is a 6mm pellet available in bulk (min. 6MT order) and 1MT Bulka Bags.

- No urea (non-protein nitrogen) used in these pellets
- Does not contain any Restricted Animal Material
- Should only be used for sheep
- Withholding periods Meat and Milk: NIL

This product is suitable for sheep only. Pasture quality, climate, breed and age of the sheep will give different results. Please use the feeding method as a guide only and ensure pellets are introduced gradually.
